Presently am at college, pursuing a Diploma in clinical medicine and community health at Fort portal college of Health sciences. I am in Year 2 semester 2. The programme runs for 3 years, of which each year has two semesters.

In holidays I do hospital based practice as a clinician in Walukuba Health centre IV, Jinja run by government to equip myself with practical health skills that is nursing care, clerkship, performing tests in laboratory, dispensing patients and many more. My hobby is reading story books and researches attributed to my field of interest requiring updated knowledge.

The Diploma in clinical medicine and community health programme has introduced me to medical knowledge both theoretical and practical. I am able to handle clients' needs to the improvement of their health and well being. I hope it is a stepping stone for me to achieving more.
